Representative Membership Application Form

Membership and Benefits: Student Organizations are only required to send one (1) liaison to GPSGA General Assembly meetings. **Academic Units** are required to send two (2) representatives. In the case of an organization which represents both a Student Group and the Academic Unit, dual representation is allowed and only two (2) representatives are required. Members of GPSGA will have several benefits, including: (1) the opportunity to apply for Graduate Student Group Funds (GSGF) for their student organizations, (2) the opportunity to apply for travel grants for individual students represented within academic units or student organizations (maximum of \$250 for regional conferences, a maximum of \$500 for national conferences and a maximum of \$750 for international conferences), (3) the opportunity to make choices about funding graduate events through co-sponsorship and voting on legislation that directly impacts graduate students (e.g. health insurance, daycare, etc.), and (4) the opportunity to work within a multidisciplinary, multicultural organization with many leadership and collaborative professional opportunities.

Membership Requirements: In order to be eligible for the aforementioned benefits, members representing an Academic Unit or Student Organization have several requirements, including: (1) regular attendance at general assembly meetings (defined as attendance at a minimum of 75% of all scheduled meetings per organization or unit) and (2) active contribution to a GPSGA or approved campus-wide committee, which includes signing up and performing duties consistent with the committee leader's expectations. This will vary by committee, but will be explained by the leaders of the committee after you register to participate and meet with your respective committees.
