# GPSGA Graduate Student Group Funds Application Guidelines

To apply for the GPSGA Graduate Student Group Funds, please follow the guidelines outlined in this document.

### To be eligible for grant funding:

- ✓ The applicant's graduate student group should be recognized by GPSGA.
- ✓ The graduate student groups should be in good standing with the GPSGA for both Fall and Spring (please check our website for the standing status of your group) semesters. Clearly, the student group should have a good standing with GPSGA atleast two semester as of the application submission deadline.

### Evaluation procedure:

The Finance Committee will evaluate the applications and send an email containing the meeting time to a representative designated by the groups. The president and treasurer of a group (or) one among them should be available to meet the committee. The GSGF committee will allocate funds to the group based on the meeting. The total funds set aside for GSGF funds will be divided among the groups that are eligible.

**Application deadline:** Submit the filled forms by 5:00 P.M. on the third Friday of March
